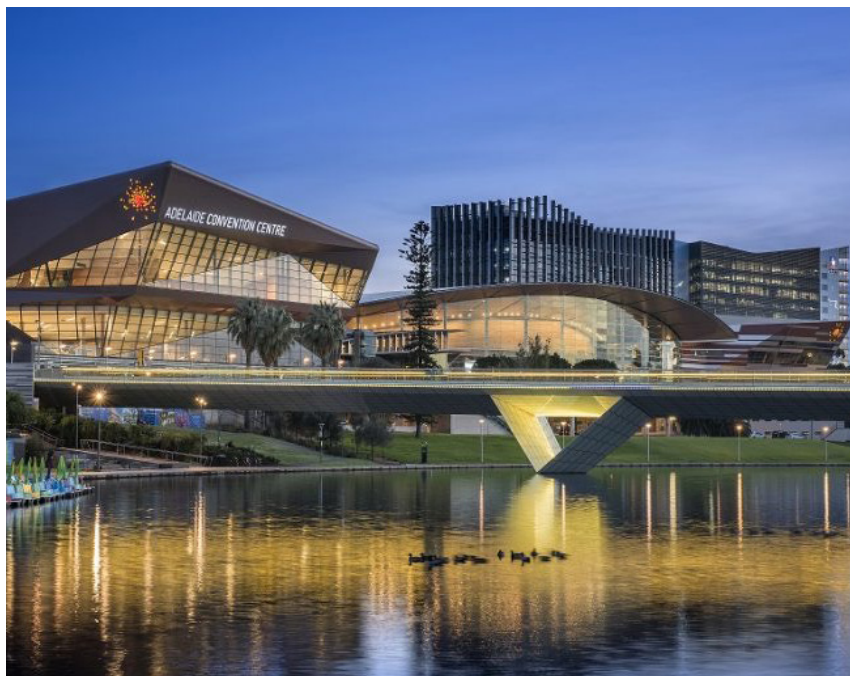


19th World Rose Convention

The World Rose Convention will be hosted by the National Rose Society of Australia Inc. with the support of its five State Rose Societies, the Government of South Australia, the Adelaide City Council and the Adelaide Convention Bureau. It will be held in the internationally acclaimed and recently upgraded Adelaide Convention Centre.

Australia is renowned for all aspects of rose culture as our climate provides ideal growing conditions. With nearly 3,500 members, the National Rose Society of Australia is one of the most respected and successful societies of its kind worldwide and Adelaide is known as the City of Roses.

The Convention is also staging a large scale public exhibition. This will be an indoor rose and green life exhibition incorporating the Australian Rose Championships together with a floral display.

Our Rosamond **Bred for Australian conditions** **February 2019** **an initiative of Ausrose Promotions**

Our Rosamond is one of the many outstanding roses bred by highly regarded Victorian rosarian Ron Bell.

Our Rosamond is a tall growing hybrid tea having pale pink blooms with deep pink edged petals that are slightly darker on the reverse side. The classically shaped high centred blooms and have won numerous champion ribbons on the show bench. One such win being champion exhibition bloom at the Sydney Royal Easter Show.

The almost thornless bush with attractive green foliage produces an abundance of mildly fragrant blooms that have an excellent vase life.

Ron Bell is one of the standout rosarian of the last century being an administrator, breeder and author. As an administrator he served long periods as Secretary, Treasurer and Subscription Secretary of the Victorian Rose Society.

Like many rosarian administrators he turned to breeding registering roses his breeding led to him writing the book "Amateur Guide to Rose Breeding".

Over his long and illustrious career, Ron was recognised for his contributions to the rose with numerous awards these being:- Stewart Memorial Award 1979, Australia Rose Award 1987, Order of Australia 1993 and International Award for Rose Breeding 1999

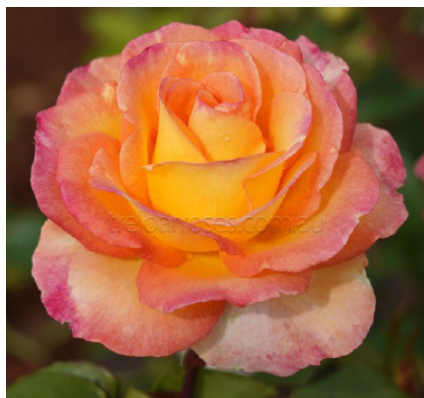

The Jubilee Rose

(Brunallen) - Bred in Australia by Bruce Brundett. This magnificent rose will flower prolifically, displaying intense colour through-out the season.

The yellow, fragrant blooms have a contrasting red petal edge and are borne on long stems that are suitable for a vase. Height to approximately 1.5m to 1.7m tall x 1m to 1.2m wide.

The Jubilee Rose will be a reminder of your past jubilee, it is also a reminder to us that 2018 was 125 years of continuous involvement in the rose industry by generations of Brundetts.

This new rose is exceptionally quick to produce fragrant blooms, with new growth commencing before the blooms are spent.

The colour rarely fades with the sun, usually deepening the yellow hue to orange flushes.

The blooms have a strong fragrance and the bushes grow to a height to 80cm.

The large fully double blooms repeat in flushes throughout the season and can be used as cut flowers or on the showbench. Strong bushy growth to about to approximately 1.5m to 1.8 tall.

Toni is the first rose registered by Paul and is named after his wife. Since this particular rose, Paul has bred a number of roses including Lenny, Bride's Bouquet, Governor Marie Bashir, Lady Endo, and Toni Stallwood.

Paul is not only a a breeder of fine roses but is a world recognised author having written the WFRS Awarded book "Growing Roses".

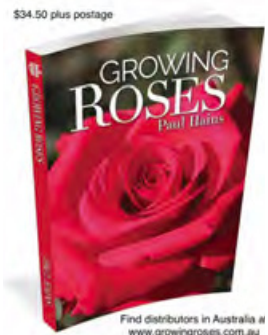

VICTORIA GOLD - bred for Australian conditions an initiative of Ausrose Promotions

Victoria Gold is a vivid gold, eye-catching Floribunda rose, bred by Australian rose breeder, Eric Welsh. It was released to commemorate the Centenary of the Victorian Rose Society in 1999.

Victoria Gold is a perfect plant for those with restricted space, growing to a maximum of 90cm in height and width. The flowers are a rich golden yellow and are generally borne in clusters up to 7 blooms per stem. The dark green foliage forms a lovely contrasting backdrop to the bright yellow flowers. Like many gold coloured roses, Victoria Gold is one of the first roses to flower in Spring and can regularly repeat bloom until early winter. The individual petals can take on a fine red edge in cold weather.

The plant is very disease resistant and a good performer in our hot climate. Victoria Gold produces a vibrant display as an individual bush, a standard rose, grouped to form a bed of roses or a low hedge. We can all be very proud of this wonderful Australian bred rose.

The rose was introduced in 1981 and is a repeat-flowering bush bearing ovoid buds that open to silvery pink, exhibition-style, high centred blooms with deeper carmine pink on the petal edges. There is an intense fragrance. Foliage is tough and is matt green on a short, bushy shrub.

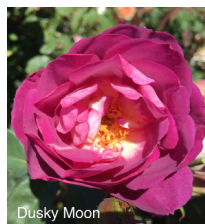

Named in memory of the doyen of contemporary Australian rose breeders, Dr Bruce Chapman.

Bruce bred the rose the rose is similar in lots of ways to its pollen parent White Spray. The double blooms form in small clusters with light yellow centres, white reverse and an average diameter of 8cm. The bush is a medium upright bush with medium green foliage.

With two grand champion wins and five champion wins at the 2016 Sydney Royal Easter Show the rose appears to have a great future on the show bench.

Other outstanding show roses bred by the Doctor include:- Joyce Abounding, Flemington Racecourse and Amazing Grace.

Bred by Dr Bruce Chapman and introduced to Australia in 2010 by Ross Roses, Red Gem is a miniflora with red exhibition style blooms that are very full. The bush is compact with glossy green foliage and an abundance of blooms either singularly or in small clusters.

The rose has been shown very successfully in NSW by Mark McGuire over a number of years. Like Joyce Abounding Red, Gem strikes readily and does very well on its own roots.

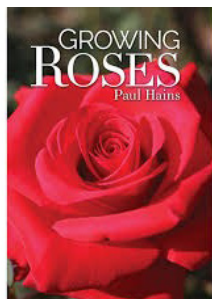
