



Bred by Eric Welsh and introduced by Rose Hill Roses in 1994 Delicious and has stood the test of time and is still much sought after for both the garden and the show bench. The quality blooms have 26 to 40 petals, strong fragrance and are of good quality however they mature quickly so for maximum beauty they should be picked early in their development. Delicious does very well on the show bench and has been known to win a championship ribbon or two. The bush grows to height of 80 cm by 60 cm wide and is very vigourous. Grows healthy plants from cuttings isn't a problem and like most miniatures Delicious grows well in pots.
