A hybrid tea, Megan Louise was bred by notable Australian Rose Breeder Eric Welsh and was named after his eldest daughter.

The rose was introduced in 1981 and is a repeat-flowering bush bearing ovoid buds that open to silvery pink, exhibitionstyle high centred blooms with deeper carmine pink on the petal edges. There is an intense fragrance. Foliage is tough and is matt green on a short, bushy shrub. A generous man Eric made a donation to the National Rose Society of Australia for each bush sold.
