The most well-known of the roses bred by Australian rose breeder Alistair Clark Lorraine Lee is an extremely large bush being 2m x 2m. Are prolific bloomer Lorraine Lee will bloom from November to September with regular removal of spent blooms. The blooms are soft pink apricot that beginning as elegant buds opening into a cupped bloom with a strong fragrance. Reasonably resistant to disease Lorraine Lee is however susceptible to powdery mildew. Although having faults Lorraine Lee is of such historical significance it deserves a place in any keen rosarian's rose garden. A climbing version of Lorraine Lee is also available but needs plenty of room as it is reasonably vigorous having rosa gigantea in its breeding.
